Pola Day 9.5%

Hydrogen Peroxide - Ideal for the A & B shades, patients with limited to no discomfort. They will do 1 treatment a day for 30 minutes if they are using a custom tray.

Pola Day CP 35%

Ideal for non-vital tooth whitening, if patients are using this concentration to whiten daily, they will do 1 treatment a day for 15 minutes.



Pola Night 16%

Carbamide Peroxide - Ideal for the C & D shades, this concentration is worn for a minimum of 90 minutes to overnight and stays active the longest giving it time to break down the long stain molecules.




Carbamide Peroxide - Ideal for patients that have expressed sensitivity concerns already but still want something quick. They will do 1 treatment a day for 45 minutes.

Pola Night 10%

Carbamide Peroxide - This concentration can be used in conjunction with aligner therapy, the patent can wear a minimum of 2 hours to overnight in their aligners.





Pola Light 9.5%

Hydrogen Peroxide (Red/Blue Light) This is a prefabricated option for a quick 5 day whitening boost, no impressions or custom tray lab work needed. The patient will complete 2 × 10 minute treatments a day.

Pola Light 22%

Carbamide Peroxide (Blue Light), the patient will complete 2 × 15 minute treatments a day.
